STIPULATIONS AND BY-LAWS FOR
THE MCLIVAIN EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

NAME: The Mclivaine Educational Scholarship
PURPOSE: To encourage young scholars to pursue a career in education
AMOUNT: \$1,000 annually

1. The scholarship will be awarded annually to a Norway High School graduating senior intending to pursue a college degree in the area of education (teaching).
2. The recipient must have attended either Burbank or Sterling School for a period of no less than one year.
3. To qualify to receive the award; the student must have maintained a "C" or better scholastic average during the four years of high school.
4. The recipient must use the scholarship no later than one year after it is awarded.
5. Disbursement of the funds will be sent directly to the school of choice.
6. The scholarship may be used for a student in any type of higher education such as a two-year or four-year program.
7. Selection of the recipient will be made by a committee of three, the Norway High School Principal, the Dean of Students and, until the year 2008, Mrs. Nan Mclivaine.
8. Initial presentation of the scholarship will be made at the 2003 Graduation program and thereafter at the annual spring Honors Banquet.
